

To the Directors of the Abba Drinking Water Project, In the past many others have despised our village because we are all dalit families and our main profession is snake catching and we have few families who are infected by leprosy. So we have never received any benefits from the government authorities. Because of this sickness our villagers were never allowed to even fetch water from common wells in other villages. We have had a very hard time to survive with small pond we had in our village and some times it also dries up. We can only say it this way.. Abba Drinking Water Project and its team came from God after hearing our prayers and cry.. The team prayed with us and expressed so much of compassion and they brought the drill machine in with two weeks and drilled a 130 meter deep bore well and erected a huge water tank and connected it to a electric pumping motor but only after the bore well was finished the team was shocked to know that our village never had electric connect atall. We thought the ABbba team would give up but for our surprise they brought electricity authorities the next day to our village and the organization paid it to bring electric connection into our village all the electric wires and posts had to be brought from about 8 kilometers far away. So now our village has got double blessing one is the clean, fresh drinking water and the other electric connection which has brought light into our village. Chankyou Abba. May your mission continue to bring Hope, Light and future many more in the days to come.

- Literates in Neyyadivakkam are 896 (66%).
- There are 464 total Illiterates (34%).
- Workers are 652 (48%).
- ♦ There are 708 Non Workers (52%).
- Further the children below 6 years of age are 140 of which 62 are males and 78 are females.
